I-87(Northway) to Exit 18.  
Travel east on Broad Street into the City of Glens Falls (approx 1.2 miles).  
Veer right on to Hudson Street.  
Travel through traffic circle to Ridge Street (approx 3/4 mile).  
The Queensbury Hotel will be on your left (approx 1/4 mile).

### From Points East (VT):

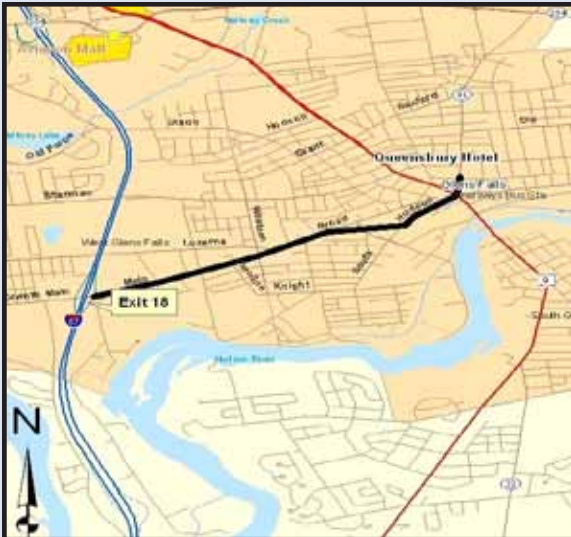
Take Route 4 to Route 149 west in the Village of Fort Ann.
